



# **Acceptable Forms of ID**

Two pieces of ID are required for the mandatory credit check.

#### Only Acceptable Forms of ID

- Canadian driver's license\* •
- Social insurance number + valid government-issued photo ID •
- Major Canadian credit card + valid government-issued photo ID •

\*IMPORTANT: You CAN NOT use a driver's license for both Photo ID and Credit check.

#### Acceptable Forms of Photo ID

<ul> <li>Non-expired Canadian Conditions:</li> <li>Both the province and expiry date are required.</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>All Canadian provinces (except Quebec)</li> <li>Obtained via Provincial government, Motor Vehicles Branch, Registry Offices.</li> <li>Provincial IDs are called different names according to the province issuer:</li> </ul>
